PLOUGHING TIME OF YEAR



The annual ploughing matches are a tradition that date back many hundreds of years and they still take place throughout the country.

Matt Rowland from the farm went along to a ploughing match at Raglan to practice his skills.

Land is ploughed in order to turn over the upper layer of the soil, bringing fresh nutrients to the surface, whilst burying weeds, the remains of previous crops, and both crop and weed seeds, allowing them to break down. It also provides a weed-free medium for planting the next crop.

Without the plough we wouldn't be able to run our organic farm on the scale that we do today.

Calves are born all year round here on the farm but the last few months have been particularly busy for 'our girls', with over 100 calves born since mid-July.
