SLURRY SPREADING WITHOUT THE SMELL



As an organic farm we are always very keen on recycling the high quality nutrients from our cattle waste (slurry) back to our crops. It's the natural circle of life but, unfortunately, the traditional method of spreading it onto the fields releases some of the nitrogen which has a rather unpleasant odour!

This year we've invested in new state-of-the-art machinery that enables us to spread the slurry directly onto the soil, helping to stop the nitrogen getting into the atmosphere and reducing the slurry smell drastically.

Increased yields of crops, improved carbon footprint. Happy farmer and happier neighbours!
