FIRE ON THE FARM

When we were bedding down our cattle with fresh straw at 6am on a cold February morning our straw chopper machine burst into flames.

As soon as we realised that we weren't going to be able to control the flames ourselves we



towed the burning machine from the building, unhitched it from the tractor to prevent any further damage, and called the Fire Brigade. It took a couple of hours and a second tank of water before the fire was fully out. Needless to say that we'd like to say how very grateful we are to the Chepstow Fire Brigade for their prompt action.

MUCK SPREADING

It's that smelly time of year again! We're spreading compost, manure and slurry ready to plough and plant barley, maize, peas and clover grass. As an organic farm we operate an 8 year crop rotation in order to build up the fertility of the land. That's grass and clover for 5 years, cereal crops for 2 years and then peas and barley for 1 year.

We've been a little delayed due to the wet weather but we'll be letting the milking herd back into the fields any day now.
