Over the years Hanley Farm Shop has become a culinary showcase for numerous local food and drinks producers, giving many of them a unique opportunity to display and sell their wares that they otherwise wouldn't necessarily have had.

TRY BEFORE YOU BUY

Our kitchen chefs use only the freshest of ingredients to prepare the meals that we serve in our Café, most of which we actually sell in the shop.

So if there's a specific dish or a condiment that you particularly like please ask one of the team because its more than likely that we stock the majority of the ingredients.

Our jams and marmalades come from Claire's Kitchen, Sedbury near Chepstow, butter from Netherend Farm, Woolaston, milk and



cream from Mead Farm, Redwick, eggs from Prewetts of Trellech, smoked salmon from Severn and Wye Valley Smokery, Westbury-on-Severn, and fresh local meat from our own Butchery, cheeses from our Deli, vegetables from local growers and suppliers that we know and trust and even some grown by members of our landshare scheme in the field behind the shop.....and you can't get much fresher than that!

Some of the more specialty items are sourced from a little further afield, like our dressings from The Bay Tree, just down the road in Somerset and our chutneys and pickles from Tracklements in Wiltshire.

Of course, you can have pretty much anything on our Café menu to take



away if you prefer. You'll also find a selection of our most popular dishes ready-prepared and frozen for you to heat up at home – things like chilli-con-carne, chicken curry seafood platter and occasionally one or two of our weekly specials.
