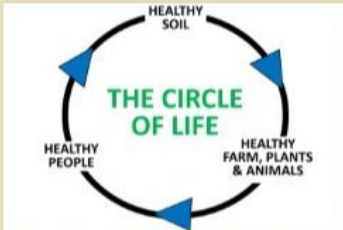

CIRCLE OF LIFE

It may well sound like a song from a Disney cartoon but the 'Circle of Life' is actually a simple formula to help us all to appreciate just how easy it is to change to a healthier lifestyle. The healthier the soil, the healthier the plants that grow, the healthier the animals that graze and the healthier the people who eat the produce, drink the milk from the cows, etc.

SOIL TESTING

We're one of only three farms in the UK, including the Duchy Home Farm at Tetbury and a technical demonstration farm in Leicestershire, taking part in a Europe-wide trial on managing soil organically. It involves regular analysis of our soil and reporting back

the results to enable us to continually improve its biological and nutritional contents, including counting the number of earthworms per square metre. Interestingly, we've just heard that our farm land has the highest earthworm count which means exceptionally healthy soil!

GROWING NUMBERS

Now entering our 6th year in business we've been crunching some numbers for Hanley Farm Shop. The number of people visiting us last year has increased four-fold compared to our first year. When we opened our doors in 2013 we had just 6 team members and we now employ 26, 4 of which are new positions for our upcoming extended
