We're gearing up for a busy summer season. We've just made our first of six monthly cuts of silage. It's mostly grass and clover which we cut and wilt for 24 hours, pick up with our new forage wagon (pictured above, gathering up the first cut) and transport to our silage stores.

Here it's consolidated to exclude any air which allows the natural sugars to pickle it and preserve its high natural nutritional value for winter feeding.
