In June we threw open our gates to the public again so you could see for yourself exactly what goes on behind the scenes of a working organic dairy farm like ours.

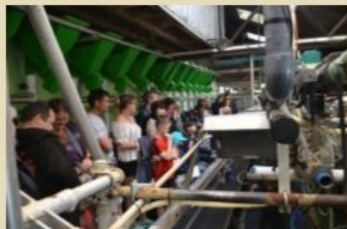

We're proud of our organic farm status. We don't use any pesticides or herbicides on the crops that we grow and feed to our animals so weeding



takes us a bit longer and on an industrial scale! We also use only natural remedies for our milking herd if ever any of the girls is feeling under the weather so you can be sure that there's no antibiotics or any other chemicals getting into your food.
