BEEF FROM OUR FARM

The beef in our butchery comes from our own farm. Our Aberdeen Angus and Hereford cattle are all naturally grass fed. No chemicals, no drugs and reared in line with our organic farm ethos. The meat is traditionally hung for at least 21 days which gives it its unique dry aged flavour. Our butchers rave about it and so do our customers. In fact, all of our meat comes from local suppliers that we know and trust

CIRCLE OF LIFE

(our simple formula)
Grass takes carbon out of the atmosphere. Cows eat the grass which they digest and convert into food (meat). The waste is absorbed back into the soil which stores the carbon. This helps reduce global warming and enrich the soil to grow more grass to feed the cows. That's why beef that's raised outdoors is better for you and better for the environment.
